Staff Training at MTU



The EEHE staff training was conducted in Mandalay Technological University (MTU) from 20th to 24th November in target departments of Electrical Power, Electronics, Mechatronics, Mechanical, CEIT* and Workshop. 15 Japanese professors and 1 technical staff from Japanese Supporting Universities were dispatched and more than 100 academic staff and technical staff from MTU and Yangon Technological University (YTU) joined the training. The objectives of this training is to improve the practice/experiment of COE program**, to plan COE 6th year program, and to enhance the research activity of academic staff in both universities. In order to meet objectives, laboratory manuals and reports for experiment on some subjects were reviewed and revised, some demonstration of experiment were conducted, and the graduation project for COE 6th year were discussed. In addition, Japanese professors used a lot of time to advise on research, how the theme be decided, how to experiment, the importance of collaboration among academic staff & students including Japanese professors, and research space for students, etc. In the workshop, equipment operating skills were trained and some maintenance equipment were provided. EEHE Project continues holding staff training in both universities during the project term.
